**ENTRIES:** Mail entry and check payable to Pacific Equestrian Center (PEC), 10992 Wilton Rd. Wilton, CA 95693. Scratches prior to closing date refunded in full, less \$20 scratch fee. Faxed entries accepted with \$10 fax fee. Late fee of \$20 for entries accepted after closing date. **NO REFUNDS FOR STABLING OR CLASSES AFTER CLOSING, FOR ANY REASON.** Freestyle entries must include a copy of eligibility test and music on compact disc and given to the show secretary upon arrival. Return check fee \$25.

**FEES:** Shows #1, #2, #4, #6 & #7 Fees are \$25 per class. Office fee \$10. Shows #3 & #5 Fees are: Introductory Level - \$40. Training Level thru Fourth Level - \$50. FEI - \$65. Freestyle - \$55. USDF Qualifying class add \$10 per class. Office fee of \$25. Show #5 Breed Show fees are \$55 per class. NON-Competing horses \$50 a day.

**TIMES:** Ride times available 3 days before show. Ride times, prize lists, and results will be available at [www.pecsportshorses.com](http://www.pecsportshorses.com).

**AWARDS:** Ribbons thru 5th place. 1st award for class of 3 or more. High Score Award Open, Adult Amateur, and Junior. Schooling Series High Score championship coolers (must attend 3 of the 5 shows).

**STABLING:** Limited stabling available. Permanent box stalls (12x12), shavings included \$35/day NOT night.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/FOOD:** Holiday Inn Express, Bond Rd. at Hwy 99. Call 916-478-9000. Gourmet lunch will be available.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Hwy 99 take Grantline Rd. exit; go east to Wilton Rd.; turn right/ 1.8 miles on right. Mapquest 10992 Wilton Rd. Wilton CA 95693.

**VETERINARIAN:** On call. Posted in office.

**FOOTING:** Two sand competition dressage courts; indoor warmup with Airfoot and sand, covered lounging area (20 meters).

**OTHER:** Dogs must be on a leash. Videographer and digital photography available.

## DRESSAGE ARENA PYLONS

Pylons are manufactured in two weights and grades of Rotational Molded Polyethylene Plastic, not Fiberglass. They measure 16" by 17" at the base and are 15" tall.

### MODELS AVAILABLE

**CROSS LINK:** Heavy duty model, molded in two different directions. These are the best for an arena that is set up at all times, winter and summer.

**LINEAR:** Light duty model, molded in one direction only. These are the best for an arena that would be set up for short periods of time, taken down and stored under cover.

**FULL SIZED COURT** (3 meter sections) Consists of 14 white and 48 black pylons.

**FULL SIZED COURT** (2-meter sections) Consists of 14 white and 70 black pylons.

**SHORT COURT** (3-meter sections or 2-meter sections)

Arenas can be ordered in reverse colors or all one color.

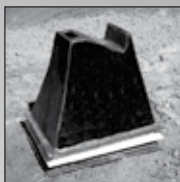
Rails are not included. At least 3 inch PVC pipe is recommended to avoid sag.
